Who needs it?

Any elderly person who needs assistance with routine daily activities

Any adult with a doctor-approved health order for a skilled need

What services?

Wide range of non-medical help (ie: transportation, house help, bathing, meal prep, med reminders)

Skilled nursing, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, social work services

Who are the workers?

Trained, compassionate caregivers. Some are CNAs, some are not.

RNs, Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Speech Therapists, Social Workers

Who pays for it?

Usually clients pay out-of-pocket. Other options: Long Term Care Insurance, VA Benefits, Worker's Compensation

Medicare, Commercial Health Insurance

How long are they there?

Caregivers can stay for extended periods, anywhere between 2-24 hours a day

30 minutes - 1 hour
